

ATTENTION PARENTS OF FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP
THREE AND FOUR YEAR OLDS!!!

Franklin Township is looking for three and four year old children to attend a half-day inclusive preschool program. This program integrates preschoolers with diverse capabilities.

The program runs 4 days a week (Monday through Thursday) for 2 1/2 hours per day.

The session lasts from 9:00 to 11:30. The program is instructed by a teacher certified in both general and special education and supported by paraprofessionals. A speech therapist is available in the program a few times a week. It follows a state approved curriculum.

There are a LIMITED NUMBER of spaces available for children who meet the following criteria:

- Children must turn 3 by October 1, 2010 but may not be older than 4.
- Children must be toilet trained
- Parents are responsible for transportation
- Tuition is \$325/ month for 10 month (September through June)

Preference will be given to Franklin Township residents, but nonresidents may apply.

Tuition may be waived or reduced by 50% for eligible low-income families. Low-income qualification will be determined using the same guidelines as the Federal Free and Reduced Lunch Program.

Applications will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis. They are available at the Franklin Township School or on the website at www.ftschoool.org.
