D. EFT Claimant Certification (Electronic Funds Transfer)

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board adopt the following required under Local Finance Notice #2018-13, distributed on 3/29/18 addressing electronic funds transfer or “EFT” and claimant certification changes and requirements:

The School Business Administrator/Board Secretary shall be responsible to initiate a claim for payment using an EFT method that has been approved in accordance with the N.J.S.A. 18A:19-1 et seq. and Policy and Regulation and to make the payment once authorization is granted.

The Superintendent of Schools or the Superintendent’s designee not under the direct supervision of the School Business Administrator/Board Secretary shall be responsible to review and authorize, in writing, the EFT payment of claim using an EFT technology that was initiated and presented by the School Business Administrator/Board Secretary.

An employee, non-employee, Board President, or other individual who is not under the direct supervision of the School Business Administrator/Board Secretary shall be responsible to review all EFT weekly Activity Reports on all EFT-based transactions.

E. Designate Official Newspapers

WHEREAS, Chapter 231 of the Public Laws of NJ (1975) known as, and hereinafter designated as, the “Open Public Meetings Act” requires notification of meetings of public bodies, as therein defined, in the manner there in set forth, now therefore be it
