FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF EDUCATION

RESIGNATION/REMOVAL FROM OFFICE

Whenever a member of the Franklin Township Board of Education shall cease to be a bona fide resident of the district which he/she represents, membership on the Board shall immediately cease. Any member who fails to attend three consecutive meetings of the board without good cause may be removed.

Vacancies created by the resignation or removal of a board member shall be filled within 65 days. The individual filling the vacant position shall serve until the organizational meeting following the next annual election. If the board shall fail to fill the vacancy within such time, the Executive County Superintendent shall fill the vacancy for the unexpired term (see board policy 9113 Filling Vacancies).

Resignation or Removal from the Office of President/Vice-President

A board member serving as president or vice-president who refuses to perform a duty required by law may be removed from the office of president or vice-president by a majority vote of all members of the board.

Any vacancy in the office of president or vice-president due to resignation or removal of office shall be filled within 30 days thereafter by nomination of candidates followed by a closed ballot. The candidate receiving majority vote of all members present shall be appointed to fill the office for the remaining unexpired term.
